14. <b>Sauvignon Saint Maur 2009</b> River Farm, New Zealand [13.5% abv] <i>Tiny production from this quality estate in Marlborough, New Zealand. If you're a fan of Cloudy Bay then get involved. Boutique kiwi sauvignon blanc at its finest.</i>			£38.00
15. <b>The FMC, Chenin 2009</b> Ken Forrester Wines, South Africa [14% abv] <i>Chenin Blanc is barrel fermented, yet retains all the elegance that you'd expect from Ken Forrester. Complex, full palate with flavours of vanilla and honey that last long on the finish. In a nutshell, South Africa does Burgundy.</i>			£44.00
16. <b>Villa di Chiesa 2008/09</b> Santadi, Italy [14% abv] <i>The deep straw yellow colour of the wine is matched by its richness on the palate.
